STEP 1

FIRST THINGS FIRST UNPLUG YOUR PINBALL MACHINE FROM THE WALL.

Remove lock down bar, playfield glass, balls and raise playfield.



STEP 2


CALL YOUR BUDDY NOW CAREFULLY lift play field straight up and out in the up position and remove playfield lean it on the side of the game. Pictured left: We have placed a moving blanket in between the playfield and the cabinet.

Remove the 3M adhesive tape backing from the back of the Left PowerBlade



STEP 4

Line up the PowerBlade with the corner cabinet nut. (Stern)



STEP 5

Allow a gap of 3/4 of an inch between the Cabinet nut and the edge of the Powerblade









STEP 6

Gently rub the Powerblade against the sideboard until it looks like this on both sides.




Route the ribbon cables around the flipper buttons in the front part of the cabinet. Make sure the ribbon cables are clear of the flipper switches and do not get entangled in them. This can cause a malfunction and damage the blades operation




Do this to both the Left and Right sides.


STEP 7

Next..Connect the ribbon connectors from the blades, into their appropriate connectors as pictured for both panels.











Note the placement of the notch on top.










Locate the 120 Volts black and white molex wired plug and separate carefully. This plug is located on the bottom left inside the cabinet, next to the coin door.






Locate the wire harness. Plug the male end of the harness into the female connector, and splice the other male connector into the female connector on the harness.








SOUND SENSITIVITY KNOB POWER SWITCH

Turn the power switch to the on position.



Turn the sensitivity knob to lowest setting at first.
